5. Number of major and minor Instruments in the Department

- In **Zoology**, Department have a well-equipped laboratory consists of specimens of all Phyla of Invertebrates and Vertebrates as well as Bones of Fowl, Charts, Pictures, Class work materials, Permanent slides, Testing Kits. The major and minor instruments include Rotary Microtome, Micropipettes, Apparatuses, Glassware's, chemicals as well as Compound and Dissecting Microscopes. Almost all specimens and instruments are used by students for regular practical purpose.

6. Study Tour:

The Department regularly organized field study tour for the all B.Sc. and M.Sc. students. In the current session, there were three field visits organized by Department:

- ✚ Field Visit was organized at Lasanpur Ashram and Goshala, Lasanpur. Tahsil- Samudrapur, district, Wardha to observe the daily routine and various problems encountered while handling of cattle.
- ✚ Butterfly walk was organized at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Park, Hinganghat to study different species of butterflies.
- ✚ M.Sc. students' field visit organized at Government Hospital, Hinganghat to observe the daily working of health workers as well as pathologists.

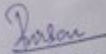
